Specialist sport coach Provision of a specialist coach for 2 PE sessions each week, all year round. Delivering, multi skills, and games.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils have accessed specialist teaching which has provided quality teaching of PE Pupils experienced a range of sports and activities they may not otherwise have had CPD opportunity for staff working alongside the coach which they have been able to embed into other sessions Lunchtime clubs have been established to provide additional opportunity to increase fitness and increase engagement particularly with pupils with ASD A whole school sports day and Comic Relief mile events organised; Race for Life planned for the Autumn term. These events have raised the aspiration across the school that everyone can participate at their level. Employment of a sports apprentice (4 days a week)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The apprentice has worked alongside the sports coach, occupational therapist, and physiotherapist and class teachers to increase physical activity across the school. The increased capacity has ensured more pupils can access small group or 1:1 intervention. The apprentice has been shadowing the OT who has a specialist in working with pupils with sensory processing disorder. The apprentice can now follow programmes which have increased the number of pupils having 1:1 sessions. These regular sessions have supported those individual pupils to participate in classroom sessions as they are more prepared for learning. The sports apprentice has undertaken a rebound therapy course which will enable her to lead rebound therapy sessions with identified pupils. The apprentice has led lunchtime clubs for pupils both in and outside. This has encouraged the pupils to be more active and increased their ability to 'play' with others. It has also led to other staff including LTAs to be more interactive at lunchtime. The sports apprentice's training has enabled her to deliver a sports day and other sports focussed events with the sports coach. She has increased confidence and ability to do this on her own next year. 	£8,990	
Employment of physiotherapist for 1:1 hydrotherapy sessions (2 primary pupils), transportation to pool, cost of pool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2 pupils have accessed a water based therapy once a week to promote physical health; joint circulation, opportunity to weight bear, promotion of relaxation.
