<p>OT sensory assessments</p> <p>Sensory resources e.g.</p> <p>Beanbags</p> <p>Bubble machine</p> <p>Light and sound toys</p>	<p>3 pupils</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sensory assessment enabled OT to develop and review child’s reaction to sensory stimuli and consider their individual sensory processing needs and difficulties</li> <li>• More able to process sensory input.</li> <li>• Better awareness and regulation of sensory information</li> <li>• Greater engagement in class activities</li> <li>• Improved emotional regulation leading to fewer instances of challenging behaviour</li> <li>• Provision of equipment and activities so that sensory input could be delivered in a playful and meaningful way</li> <li>• Sensory stimulation to calm, regulate and organise their bodies.</li> <li>• Greater attainment</li> </ul>	<p>£1,500</p>
