

## 4<sup>th</sup> July Firework Art

This paper tube Fireworks Art Project for Kids is entirely child-led and with 4<sup>th</sup> of July next week, kids will love creating their own fireworks display using this simple technique that's been used within preschools for years.

You will need:

Paper Tubes  
Kid-Friendly Paint  
Black Stock Card  
Plastic Plates  
An Old Newspaper  
Scissors

**Step 1:** To create the firework stamp, cut a number of slits into one end of the paper tube and work around the circumference leaving about a centimeter between each cut.



**Step 2:** Spread the paper tube strips outwards.



**Step 3:** Place the paper tube into a plate full of paint.



**Step 4:** Stamp the paper tube onto the black stock card.



**Step 5:** Supply your Arty Crafty Kids with multiple colours and fill the Black Stock Card with fireworks!



**Step 6:** Cut out some landscape newspaper clippings.



**Step 7:** Glue the newspaper clippings onto the fireworks painting.
