Don't forget to use all your senses! Take time to feel, smell, look, listen and taste.

Try using...

- Flowers and petals
- Leaves
- Twigs
- Rough tree bark
- Fruit (frozen berries or citrus peel are great!)
- Herbs
- Dry soil
- Seeds

Try doing...

- Changing the shape of the playdough with your hands. Can you press, squash, pinch, poke and roll the dough? How does it feel between your fingers?
- Warming the dough up or cooling it down. Feel the gooey playdough in contrast to when it is cold and stiff.
- Mixing in your small ingredients.
 Roll in herbs, seeds or petals until the texture has changed.
- Decorating your playdough with flowers, twigs and stones. Choose which colours, smells and textures you want to add to your garden.
