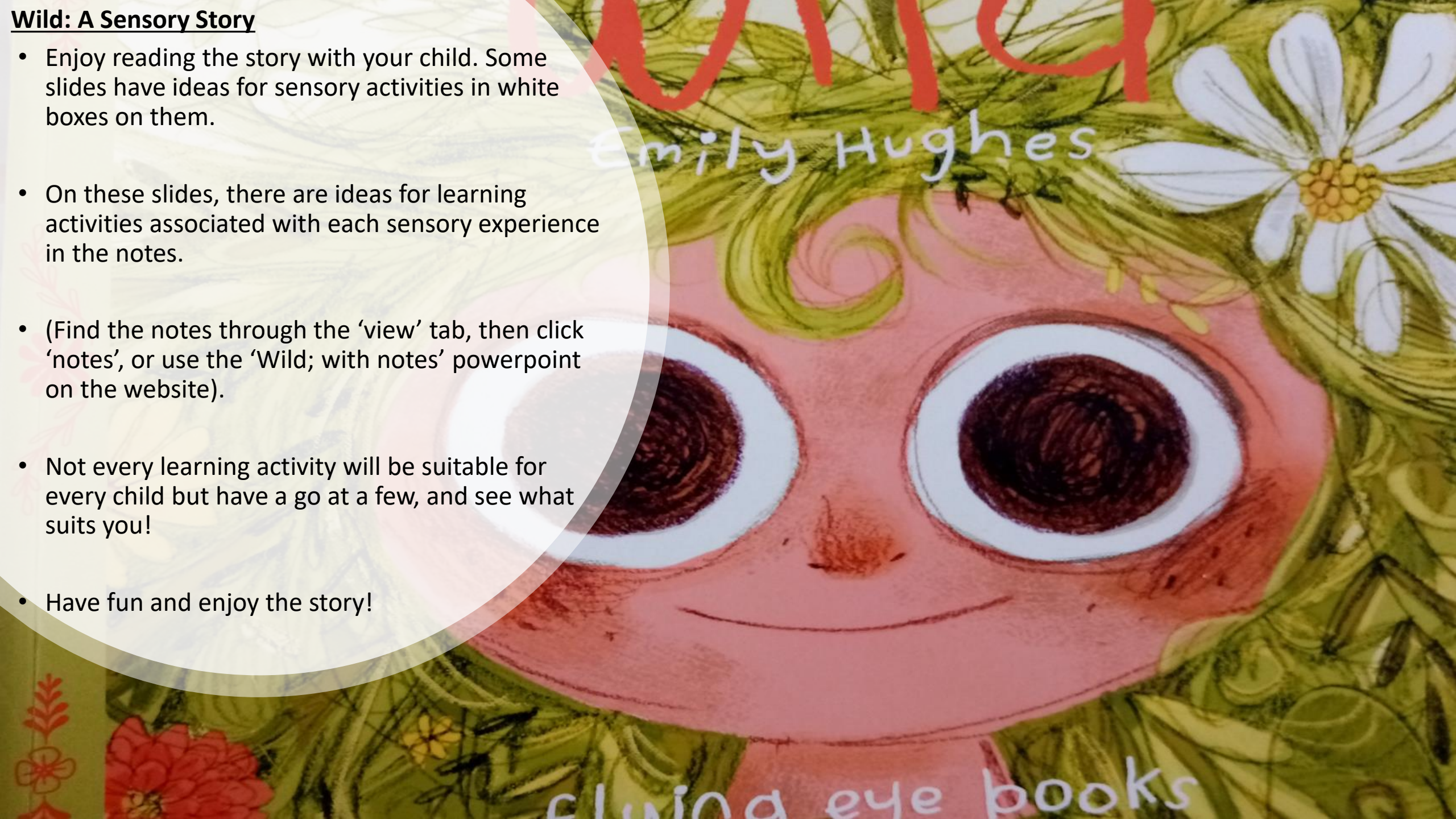


## Wild: A Sensory Story

The whole forest took her as their own.



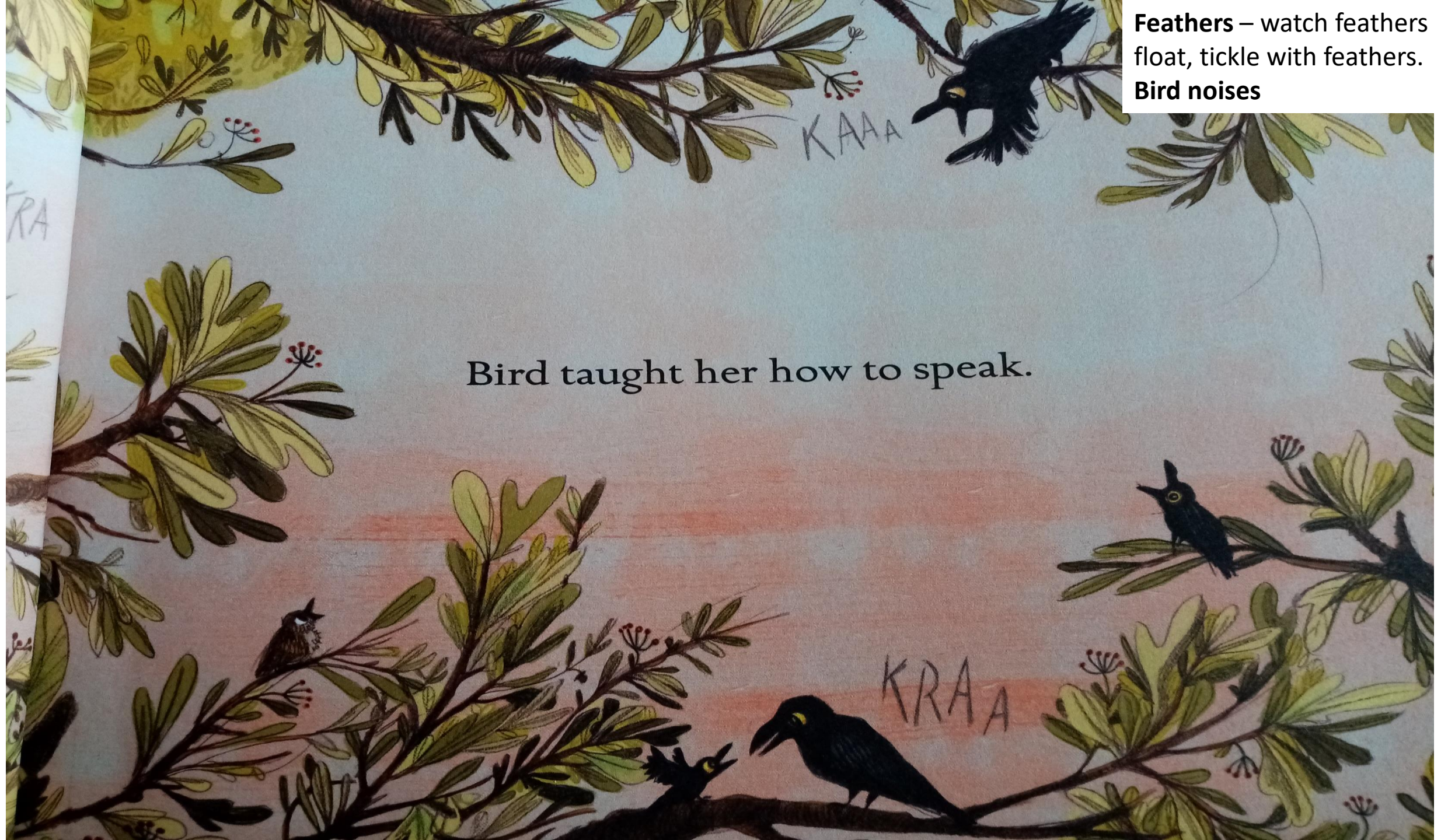






**Feathers** – watch feathers

**Bird noises**

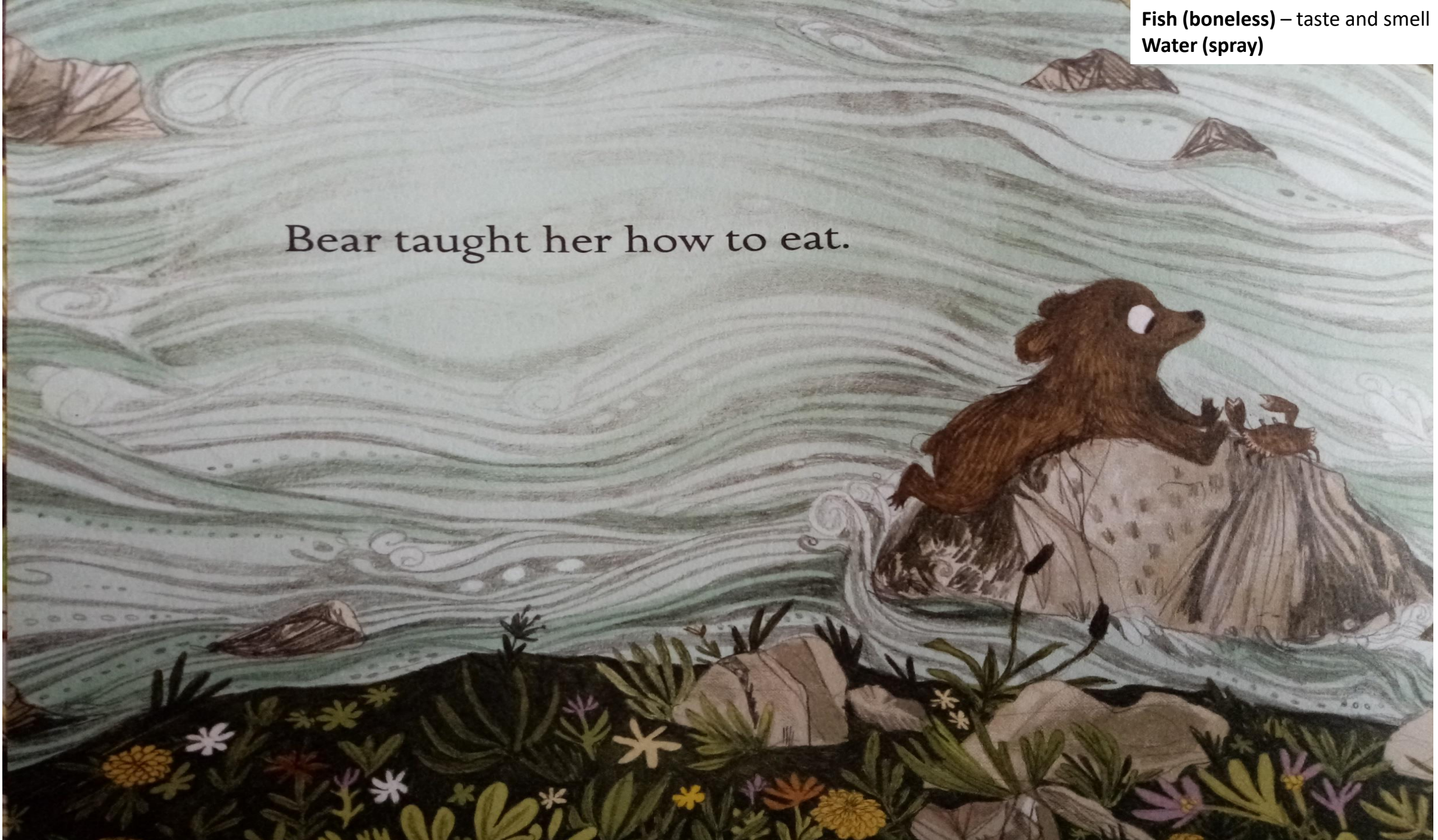
Bird taught her how to speak.

One day she met some new animals in the forest...






