## Tea and Coffee Art

No British picnic is complete without a thermos of tea or coffee! Try different types of fruit tea for a range of smells and colours.





- Select your paint! Try smelling coffee and different types of tea (red berry, green, lemon and ginger etc) to choose how you would like to paint. Put several into each cup.
- An adult will need to boil the kettle and pour a small amount of water into each cup.
