### Career Skills in the Curriculum

Work skills for all pupils will be developed through the Curriculum, including Communication, Life Skills and Cognition skills. These skills are embedded in the school curriculum and will address the needs of the individual pupils through the use of Transition Plan's (from Year 7) and IEPs throughout their school career. Through our PHSE curriculum pupils will focus on social skills, communication skills and emotional intelligence. Skills covered will include respectful relationships, being safe and mental well-being.

From Year 7 pupils will have regular and appropriate contact with employers and experience of workplaces through employee presentations, offsite visits and appropriate opportunity for work experience; this may be offsite or in school. Topic work will offer the opportunity to explore the world around them and experience different environments and the opportunities they provide. Specific work skills are embedded into this and have been identified by the career curriculum lead.

Specific career skills for each pupil will be identified through the transition plan and addressed through the IEP and curriculum. In Post 16 these skills will be developed through specific pathways and accredited courses offered to each pupil.
