Ash Lea is a special school for children from 3-18 years old with severe and complex educational needs located in Cotgrave. Ash Lea School governors are looking to recruit a resourceful and enthusiastic individual with a commitment to delivering a high standard of educational provision for a pupil from the school in their home. The role will require working within a school setting to prepare resources and support with planning one to one sessions, support with educational administrative work, to work within the classroom to familiarise themselves with the class' curriculum offer and support within the pupil's class if not needed for pupil's home learning. The role will require the person to travel to the family home when the child is ready to access learning (which may fluctuate due to health needs). It is hoped that this person will also support a successful transition for into the school setting. This will be done under the guidance and direction of the class teacher.

The successful candidate will have achieved a minimum of an NVQ level 3 or equivalent, with an educational focus. Knowledge of how children learn, early learning strategies, child protection, child development, the SEND code of practice is desirable, as well as knowledge of children with complex needs and / or acquired brain injury. Experience of working within a special educational setting as well as training in First Aid, CRB and Moving and Handling would be advantageous. The ability to work under pressure is essential. You will need to be proactive and work using your own initiative whilst being part of a wider team.

Working hours to be agreed as there may be some flexibility over start and finish times for the right candidate. This position is offered as a temporary contract to continue until the pupil has been able to make a successful transition back to school. This role will be offered as a temporary one year contract in the first instance. This role is to start as soon as possible.
