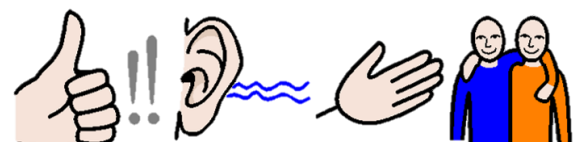

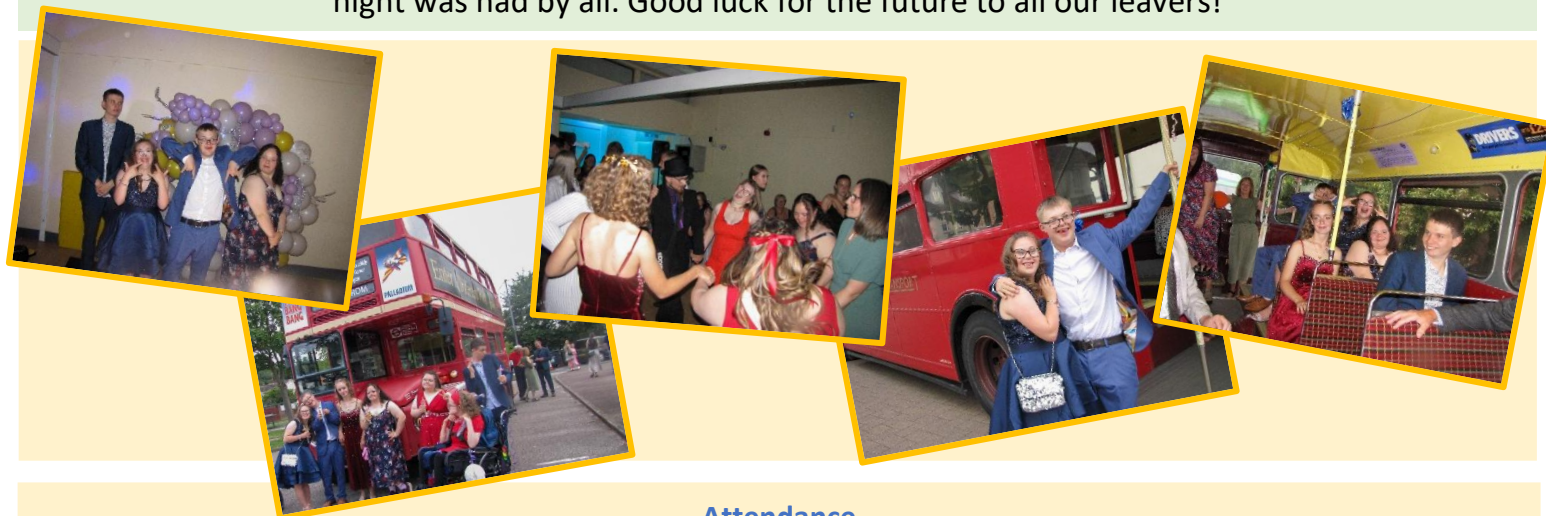
Friends Of Ash Lea School
